1. Identification details of the Data Controller (and any other subjects)

2 . Purpose of the processing

The processing of the personal data provided is aimed at:

- a) execution of the contract;
- b) fulfillment of legal obligations related to the contractual relationship;

- c) contract management, for example relationships with agents, representatives, clients and / or contractors;
- d) any external professional collaborations for the fulfillment of legal obligations;
- e) protection of contractual rights;
- f) internal statistical analysis;
- g) marketing activities by sending promotional and advertising material relating to products or services similar to those covered by the existing commercial relationship;
- h) After-sales communications;
- i) Obtain data for the billing of Services or supply of products;

The legal basis of the processing is the contract, as well as the explicit consent.

3. Processing methods

Personal data will be processed electronically and entered in the relevant databases which can be accessed by the persons in charge of data processing.

The processing may also be carried out by third parties who provide specific processing, administrative or instrumental services necessary for the achievement of the aforementioned purposes.

All data processing operations are implemented in such a way as to guarantee the integrity, the confidentiality and availability of personal data.

4. Data retention period

The data provided will be kept for the entire duration of the contractual relationship.

5. Scope of communication and dissemination of data

In relation to the purposes indicated in point 2, the data may be disclosed to the following subjects (by way of example):

- electronic payment gateway companies such as PayPal ;
- banking institutions for the management of receipts and payments;
- financial administrations or public institutions in fulfillment of regulatory obligations;
- companies and law firms for the protection of contractual rights;
- affiliates, brokers, agents, representatives;

6. Rights pursuant to art. 15, 16, 17 18, 20, 21 and 22 of the REG. EU 2016/679

We inform you that, as an interested party, you have, in addition to the right to lodge a complaint with the Supervisory Authority, the rights listed below, which you can assert by making a specific request to the Data Controller and / or to the Data Processor, as indicated in point 1.

Art. 15 - Right of access The interested party has the right to obtain from the data controller the confirms whether or not personal data concerning him is being processed and, in this case, to obtain access to personal data and information regarding the processing.

Art. 16 - Right of rectification The interested party has the right to obtain from the data controller the rectification of inaccurate personal data concerning him without undue delay. Taking into account the purposes of the processing, the interested party has the right to obtain the integration of incomplete personal data, also by providing an additional declaration.

Art. 17 - Right to cancellation (right to be forgotten) The interested party has the right to obtain from the data controller the cancellation of personal data concerning him without undue delay and the data controller is obliged to delete personal data without undue delay.

Art. 18 - Right to limit the processing. The interested party has the right to obtain from the data controller the limitation of the processing when one of the following hypotheses occurs:

- a) the data subject disputes the accuracy of the personal data, for the period necessary for the data controller to verify the accuracy of such personal data;
- b) the processing is unlawful and the interested party opposes the cancellation of personal data and requests instead that its use be limited;
- c) although the data controller no longer needs them for processing purposes, the personal data are necessary for the data subject to ascertain, exercise or defend a right in court;
- d) the interested party opposed the processing pursuant to Article 21, paragraph 1, pending verification of the possible prevalence of the legitimate reasons of the data controller with respect to those of the interested party.

Art. 20 - Right to data portability The interested party has the right to receive in a format structured, commonly used and readable by automatic device the personal data concerning him provided to a data controller and has the right to transmit such data to another data controller without impediments by the data controller to whom he provided them. In exercising their rights regarding data portability pursuant to paragraph 1, the interested party has the right to obtain the direct transmission of personal data from one data controller to another, if technically feasible.

Art. 21 - Right to object The interested party has the right to object at any time, for reasons connected to his particular situation, to the processing of personal data concerning him pursuant to article 6, paragraph 1, letters e) or f) , including profiling based on these provisions.

Art. 22 - Right not to be subjected to automated decision-making, including profiling . The interested party has the right not to be subjected to a decision based solely on automated processing, including profiling , which produces legal effects concerning him or which significantly affects his person in a similar way.
